TERMS AND CONDITIONS STATION STAFF – NETWORK RAIL

I am pleased to advise branches that after a number of years of stalling, Network Rail finally agreed to meet with us to review the terms and conditions of managed stations staff with the aim of achieving a unified set of terms and conditions. This meeting has now taken place and the outcome reported to the General Grades Committee. The following decision has been taken: -

“Referring to Decision No G737, 21st July 2009, discussions have been ongoing during which the union’s aim has been to achieve a unified set of terms and conditions for all managed stations staff, at a meeting with the company held on 19th December 2011 Network Rail has finally agreed (after years of stalling) to set up a joint working party to look at harmonising all station staff employed by the company and that working party to report to the Network Rail National Operations Council in the new year.

The RMT’s representatives on that Joint Working Party will be Bro’s Dougie Hill, Dundee Branch and Phil Boorman, Ashford No 1 Branch, (National Ops Council) Bro B Jones, Liverpool No 5 Branch and Sister B Harris , St Pancras Branch.

The General Secretary to keep this General Grades Committee apprised of all developments.
